- ◆ Interested participants will need to park in the main parking lot and wear sturdy shoes/boots for the 200 yard trek up to the Observatory.
- ◆ Friends of Eaton County Parks members and local amateur astronomers, Jason Blaschka and/or Kevin Keys, will be on hand to answer questions about the night sky.
- ◆ Program fee is \$1 per person or \$5 per family payable at donation box on site.
- ◆ Observation nights will not be held on nights with more than 30% cloud cover.
