



# Collection Points for Cooking Oil Recovery

Rethinking our dependence on natural resources by Reducing, Reusing & Recycling

Used cooking oil can be refined and reused in animal feed, as lubricant or as bio-diesel.

When disposing of cooking oil, consider this:

- ♻️ Never pour into drains. It will congeal to form clumps, blocking sewer lines and causing major damage to septic systems.
- ♻️ Never pour used cooking oil on the ground since it will attract stray animals.

Save used cooking oil in a clean container with a tight-fitting lid and take to one of the collection points located throughout Eaton County. Participating sites are listed below. Carefully pour the used oil into the tank. Clean and reuse the containers for future trips to the Cooking Oil Collection Point.
