Sharps Disposal by Mail Program

Sponsored by Eaton County Department of Resource Recovery
Rethinking our dependence on natural resources by Reducing, Reusing & Recycling

The Eaton County Department of Resource Recovery is sponsoring a program that provides residents a safer and easier alternative for disposing of medical Sharps. The BD Sharps Disposal by Mail System allows users up to three government-approved Sharps containers, along with a postage pre-paid mailing box for transportation to the destruction facility, each year.

Eaton County residents may enroll in the program through one of the participating pharmacies listed below. Upon enrolling, residents receive their first Sharps container free of charge. The second and third containers require a \$5 co-pay. Each container holds 90-100 syringes. Participants simply seal their Sharps container inside the box and place in their mailbox.
