

**POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGNS
EATON COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE**

ARTICLE 11, SECTION 11.8.3.

- Political campaign signs are not required to obtain a County Sign Permit provided the signs are installed outside the public right-of-way in such a manner as to not obstruct clear vision.
- Political campaign signs not exceeding thirty-two (32) square feet in display area are exempt from the County Zoning Ordinance.
- Political campaign signs supporting a candidate for public office shall be removed seven (7) days following the election for the office in question.
- Political campaign signs expressing a viewpoint shall be treated as an exempt sign under this Section provided they are removed after ninety (90) days.

Contact the city or township clerk to determine if the jurisdiction has its own zoning ordinance or if they fall under the county's zoning ordinance.
