SCRAP METAL / FREON CONTAINING ITEMS: THE ITEMS WILL BE RECYCLED AFTER THE FREON IS EXTRACTED.

BATTERIES: ALL BATTERIES, INCLUDING AUTOMOTIVE & MARINE BATTERIES, WILL BE ACCEPTED. **ALL LITHIUM BATTERIES & ANY BATTERIES OVER 9-VOLTS MUST HAVE THEIR CIRCUITS TAPED. NO BAGGIES ACCEPTED.**
