**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE APPLICATION FOR  
UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE  
CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING GRANT  
EXTENSION – PROSECUTING ATTORNEY**

**Introduced by the Ways and Means Committee**

Commissioner Lautzenheiser moved the approval of the following resolutions. Seconded by Commissioner Brehler.

**WHEREAS**, the Prosecuting Attorney was approved to receive Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding through the United States Department of Justice passed-through the Michigan State Police for the period of June 1, 2021 through December 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Prosecuting Attorney has been notified that an extension of the granting period is available to extend the previous grant period through September 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant would provide funding for contractual services and applicable equipment for an attorney to address coronavirus-related caseload backlog; and

**WHEREAS**, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office is desirous of submitting the grant extension to contract with an attorney to primarily manage the backlog of cases currently in the screening process.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners authorize the Prosecutor's Office to submit a grant extension to retain the grant award with an amount not to exceed \$135,715 for the period of June 1, 2021 to September 30, 2023; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Controller be authorized to approve any necessary budget amendments to increase expenditures and increase grant revenue if the grant is approved by the State of Michigan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Chairperson of the Board of Commissioners be authorized to sign any necessary documents. Carried unanimously.
