**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING TENTATIVE AGREEMENT
WITH THE CAPITAL CITY LODGE LABOR PROGRAM, INC., COMMAND OFFICERS
DIVISION, EATON COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT**

Introduced by Ways & Means Committee

Commissioner Brehler moved for the approval of the following resolution. Seconded by Commissioner Droscha.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners participated in compulsory arbitration under Public Act 312 of 1969, as amended, with the Capitol City Labor Program, Inc., (“the Union”), which represents the Command Officers Division, Eaton County Sheriff Department; and

WHEREAS, under the Act a portion of the Union’s membership is not subject to the arbitrator’s award; and

WHEREAS, the County and Union stipulated that the proceeding serve as the required fact finding proceeding for those members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ratified the Fact Finder’s Recommendation January 16, 2019 (Resolution #19-1-9) and continued to negotiate a collective bargaining agreement based on that recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the parties reached a tentative agreement to settle the collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County has been notified that the membership has ratified the terms of the tentative agreement attached to this resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners approve the tentative agreement for the collective bargaining agreement with the Capitol City Labor Program, Inc., Command Officers Division, Eaton County Sheriff Department for the period through September 30, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign any necessary documents. Nays: Freeman. Carried.
