RESOLUTION DECLARING APRIL 2019 AS NATIONAL COUNTY GOVERNMENT MONTH “CONNECTING THE UNCONNECTED”

WHEREAS, the nation’s 3,069 counties serving more than 300 million Americans provide essential services to create healthy, safe and vibrant communities; and

WHEREAS, counties provide health services, administer justice, keep communities safe, foster economic opportunities and much more; and

WHEREAS, Eaton County and all counties take pride in our responsibility to protect and enhance the health, welfare and safety of our residents in efficient and cost-effective ways; and

WHEREAS, through National Association of Counties President Greg Cox’s “Connecting the Unconnected” initiative, NACo is demonstrating how counties deliver “people-centered” services to our residents nationwide; and

WHEREAS, each year since 1991 the National Association of Counties has encouraged counties across the country to elevate awareness of county responsibilities, programs and services; and

WHEREAS, the work of the Human Services Collaborative Council and its Continuum of Care seek to connect services to those in need with agencies and non-profit organizations in the community through partnership and outreach, including the Project Connect Resource Fair to be held in August 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Eaton County Board of Commissioners do hereby proclaim April 2019 as National County Government Month and encourage all county officials, employees, schools and residents to participate in county government celebration activities. Carried.
