**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE STATE TARGETED RESPONSE GRANT
LETTER OF AGREEMENT**

Introduced by the Public Safety Committee

Commissioner Freeman moved for the approval of the following resolution. Seconded by Commissioner Bowen.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office receives funding through the U.S. Office of Drug Control Policy Byrne Memorial Grant funds to operate a jail-based residential substance abuse treatment program; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has applied for funding through the Mid-State Health Network (MSHN) State Targeted Response Grant to provide funding for the medication component of the program; and

WHEREAS, the proposed letter of agreement with MSHN will provide reimbursement for up to \$20,148 for medication for the period of October 1, 2019 through April 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee has reviewed the proposed Letter of Agreement and is recommending its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners approves the Letter of Agreement with Mid-State Health Network for the State Targeted Response Grant funding; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Controller be authorized to approve any necessary budget amendments to increase expenditures and increase grant revenue if the grant is approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairperson of the Board of Commissioners be authorized to sign any necessary documents. Carried.
