HEALTH DEPARTMENT'S DECISION TO REPEAL THE REGULATIONS  
GOVERNING ON-SITE SEWAGE AND ON-SITE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM  
EVALUATION AND MAINTENANCE**

**Introduced by the Health and Human Services Committee**

Commissioner Rogers moved for the approval of the following resolution. Seconded by Commissioner Droscha.

**WHEREAS**, the Barry-Eaton District Board of Health at its meeting on February 28, 2018, approved the repeal of the regulations governing on-site sewage and on-site water supply system evaluation and maintenance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Eaton County Board of Commissioners approves and concurs with the Barry Eaton District Board of Health's decision to repeal the regulations governing on-site sewage and on-site water supply system evaluation and maintenance in Barry and Eaton County, Michigan, also known as the Time of Sale Transfer program; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the repeal of the regulation is effective forty-five (45) days after adoption of this or similar resolutions having the same effect by the Boards of Commissioners of the member counties of the Health District.
