**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
WITH THE CAPITAL CITY LABOR PROGRAM – ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION**

Introduced by the Ways & Means Committee

Commissioner Eakin moved for the approval of the following resolution. Seconded Commissioner Lautzenheiser.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners and Eaton County Circuit Court has been in negotiations with the Capital City Labor Program, (“the Union”), which represents the Eaton County Animal Control Unit, to reach a new collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties participated in mediation on May 22, 2018 which resulted in a the attached Mediator’s Recommended Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Controller was notified that the terms of the settlement agreement were ratified by the Union’s membership; and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has reviewed the terms of the Mediator’s Recommended Settlement Agreement and are recommending its approval to the Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners approve the proposed settlement agreement for the collective bargaining agreement with the Capital City Labor Program, Animal Control Division, for the period of June 20, 2017 through September 30, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign any necessary documents. Carried.
