RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT WETLAND MITIGATION BANKING AGREEMENT

Introduced by the Public Works & Planning Committee

Commissioner moved the approval of the following resolution. Seconded by Commissioner Haskell.

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan, Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) authorizes the creation of wetland mitigation banks pursuant to the Administrative Rules for Wetland Mitigation Banking, AACS R 281.951 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Crandell Environmental LLC has proposed a wetland mitigation bank in Brookfield Township to restore 33.00 acres of forested wetland in the Kalamazoo River Watershed from a former agricultural field; and

WHEREAS, the Rules provide the County an opportunity to provide comment on the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Planning Committee has reviewed the proposed project and is recommending the County's support.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Eaton County Board of Commissioners supports the wetland mitigation bank in Brookfield Township, as proposed. Carried.
