RESOLUTION TO APPOINT COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER AND APPROVE SERVICE AGREEMENT

Introduced by the Health and Human Services Committee

Commissioner Pearl-Wright moved the approval of the following resolution. Seconded by Commissioner Bowen.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, by resolution created the Office of the County Medical Examiner; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Michael Markey, a duly licensed physician in the State of Michigan has indicated his interest in continuing to serve the County as Medical Examiner; and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee is recommending the appointment of Dr. Markey as County Medical Examiner, effective January 1, 2021, for the contractual four year term, expiring December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the financial terms of the proposed contract are for \$272,241 for 2021 and include provisions for annual increases in subsequent years based on costs, at a not to exceed rate of four percent (4%) per year; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Patrick Hansma, and Dr. David Moons have indicated their willingness in serving the County as Deputy Medical Examiners.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners appoints Dr. Michael Markey, as County Medical Examiner for the contractual term expiring December 31, 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners appoints Dr. Patrick Hansma and Dr. David Moons, as Deputy Medical Examiners; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners approves the Medical Examiner Services Agreement with Sparrow Hospital Association for the term of the appointment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign any necessary documents.
