RESOLUTION TO SCHEDULE PUBLIC HEARING FOR PROPOSED OFF-ROAD VEHICLE (ORV) ORDINANCE

Introduced by the Public Safety Committee

Commissioner Barnes moved the approval of the following resolution. Seconded by Commissioner Augustine.

WHEREAS, the Eaton County Public Safety Committee has discussed and developed a proposed Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) ordinance as provided for in MCL 324.81131; and

WHEREAS, the statute requires a public hearing to be conducted before such an ordinance can be adopted by the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the statute requires that such a public hearing be noticed by the County Clerk not less than 45 days prior to the public hearing to the county road commission, to the legislative body of each township and municipality located within the county, to the state transportation department if the road intersects a highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eaton County Board of Commissioners hereby schedule a public hearing on the proposed Off-Road Vehicle (ORV) ordinance for Wednesday, February 16, 2022 at 7:00 pm; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Board of Commissioners directs the County Clerk to publish notice of this public hearing and provide specific notice to those entities and agencies as required by MCL 324.81131(2).
