Digital Device Use Policy

Youth Programs

Eaton County Parks

We encourage families and youth to embrace technology in our summer youth programs as it provides a way for families to keep in touch, encourages children to share their excitement and pictures with their parents during the program, encourages children to use educational programs or take pictures on their device during field trips that they can later use in power point presentations.

We just ask that the kids use their device responsibly. There are two times: mid-morning and mid-afternoon when the kids can use their cell phone to check in by calling or texting. However, we do ask that they only text or call home or a caregiver. This is not time to socialize with friends over the phone.

We ask the kids to keep their phone silenced and to not text their friends and family for the rest of the day. If a parent or caregiver needs to contact a child in an emergency or urgent situation, please call Patsy Kufta, Recreation Coordinator, on her cell phone (517-862-6337) which is always turned on and serves as the contact and emergency number for the youth programs.

We also encourage the kids to use digital cameras responsibly. We do have a limited number of digital cameras available for use. If you have any questions or concerns about this policy, please contact staff by E-mail at pkufta@eatoncounty.org or call Patsy at 517-862-6337.

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What to bring?

- Campers will need to be dressed appropriate for weather conditions whatever the week may bring. Including full toed shoes, warm clothes, hat and gloves if necessary. **PLEASE DRESS APPROPRIATELY!**
- Campers **must** bring a lunch each day! Snacks will be provided!
- Your child may need bug spray and sun screen. The camp will be held outdoors.
- Campers **MUST** bring **inhaler, Epi-pen or any other medication needed for a chronic medical condition!**
- Refillable water bottle if they would like
- Backpack or bag for extra clothing and lunch storage
- Outdoor play clothes (will get dirty from dirt and paint)
